LAKESWOOD ATHLETIC BOOSTERS *Night at the Races*



Tonight, we gather to celebrate the student athletes who call Lakewood home. As they practice and compete, they cultivate teamwork, mental toughness, leadership and a strong work ethic— traits that translate positively into a life of engaged citizenship and gainful employment. Since we last met, our Rangers have won conference titles in Baseball and most recently, Boys Basketball. We've had numerous athletes compete in State Meets, highlighted by Kaydence Doxley's 2nd place finish (via a tiebreaker) in the long jump, Charlie Payne's 6th place finish in the 1600 and Zayna Muntaser's 4th straight appearance in the State Wrestling Meet. They all performed well in front of large crowds in Columbus.

But hardly anyone is watching when our cross-country runners log hundreds of miles year-round to prepare for the meets. No one watches when the football team is lifting on Saturday morning. No one is watching when our swimmers—at 6:30 am—are swimming thousands of yards just a shave a few tenths off their times. As in most endeavors, the real work happens before the "event"—in the shadows. The losses, wins and awards ceremonies are merely the last steps on a long journey. A journey that inevitably means, for any sport, hour upon hour in the weight room.

Here is some GREAT news on that front! We now have an outstanding certified Strength and Conditioning Coach that works with all 800 plus LHS athletes, 23 teams and a growing number of middle school athletes, tailoring workouts to meet their specific needs. Mr. James Gajewski (LHS '10) was captain of our football team, District Champion in the 300 hurdles, and a fine-all around student. After years of patchwork strength and conditioning, we now have a state-of-the art training program overseen by a certified strength coach.

Next up, a state-of-the-art weight room revamp, which is where you come in. Up until now, our weight room has been functional, but has become increasingly antiquated as we learn more about the science of effective weight training. The Athletic Boosters have led the way in both advocacy and funding for this endeavor because, above all, we simply want all of our student athletes to have every opportunity to succeed. They do the lifting, sweating and grueling 6:30 am workouts—we provide the opportunity to get better by raising funds, buying gear and now updating the weight room.

We are an essential part of the magic of community-based sports, the only occasion in which teams are truly organic, where athletes play largely with their childhood friends, where lifetime bonds are made between players, coaches, parents and classmates. Take a look around the room, and you will see that the students from 44107 have a great community behind them. Hardly anyone outside of our community is "looking" in, but of course that just means we are all the more vital to the journey.

Long Live Lakewood.

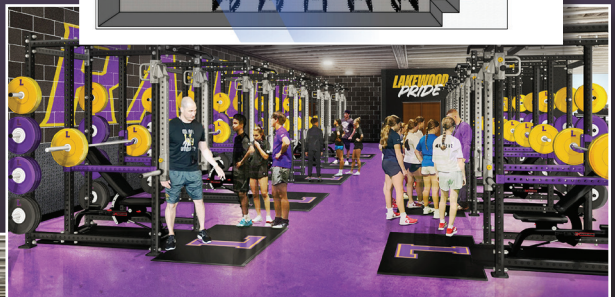
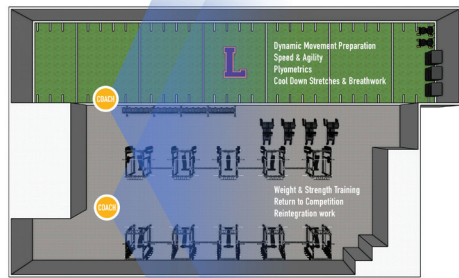

PEOPLE-POWERED PROGRESSION

The purpose of strength and conditioning and the role of Director of Sports Performance is to reduce the risk of injury and enhance the athletic performance of our student athletes. There are many factors that affect the ability to be an effective strength and conditioning coach: availability of time, space, equipment, etc. In a constraints-based system, there are limited options to create the physiological adaptations required for athletes to thrive in their respective environments.

Our program needs to mimic the stressors of competition. The stressors created need to be scalable, repeatable, periodized, and above all else, safe. New equipment in the weight room allows for training that best suits athletes of all levels and abilities. 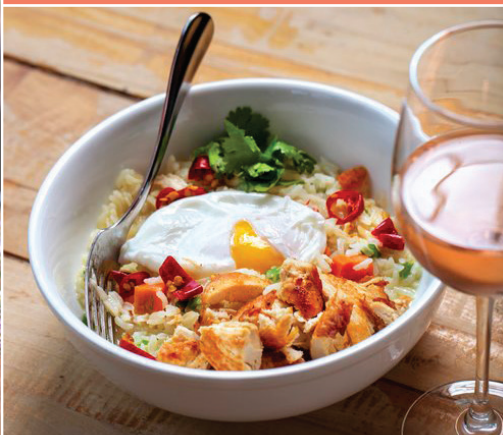
